Lectures and hands-on dry-lab covering applications of negative pressure wound therapy, linear and linear cutter staplers.



NPWT Aspect

This didactic session will cover the science behind NPWT, the various applications of negative pressure wound therapy devices (chronic and traumatic wounds, severe abscesses, lacerations etc.) how to use the device, apply and manage dressings and use the Curvage (simultaneous lavage) function of the device in lecture format. This will then be reinforced by a hands-on dry lab where participants will have a chance to use and familiarize themselves with the device, its various operating modes and accessories.

Surgical Stapling Aspect

The goal of this session is to introduce the participants to the surgical stapling equipment and techniques necessary to perform procedures such as splenectomy, liver lobectomy, cholecystectomy, adrenalectomy, nephrectomy, intestinal resection and anastomosis, gastric resection etc. The lecture will present indications, proper patient selection and follow-up care in patients. Case examples will be used to elaborate. A hands-on lab will follow, in which participants will have an opportunity to load and unload the staplers.
